Dropping off and Picking Up

At the beginning of the day, please leave your child with the teacher on duty in the morning who will be in the yard from 8.45 a.m. At the end of the day, please wait outside the classroom until the class teacher brings the children out of the classroom.

Break Time

The school has a healthy eating policy, which means that the pupils are not allowed to eat chocolate or crisps for their break-time snack. Pupils are encouraged to eat fruit at both break-time and lunch-time and all pupils are permitted to drink water throughout the day. All pupils should bring a piece of fruit and a bottle of water every day for break.

Road Safety in School

The school has a one-way system for the parents' cars in the morning and in the afternoon. Parents are asked to drive in through the black gates and drive out through the main school gates. We ask parents to keep their speed to an absolute minimum while driving on the school grounds.

Corpoideachas

Mar chuid den Churaclam Athbhreithnithe, déanfar Scileanna Bunghluaiseachta a theagasc do dhaltaí. Is é trealamh chorpoideachais Ghaelscoil Uí Néill - T-léine, briste gairide agus bróga canbháis bonnrubair. Is fusa i bhfad do pháistí bróga a tharraingítear ar chosa a láimhseáil agus ní cheadaítear bróga le hiallacha. Déantar cinnte le do thoil go bhfuil ainm do pháiste scríofa ar a gcuid trealamh.

Teanga

Mar Ghaelscoil, labhróidh an fhoireann mhúinteoireachta le do pháiste i nGaeilge. Is tábhachtach é fosta go gcluineann do pháiste Gaeilge taobh amuigh den scoil, ó thuismitheoirí, ó dheartháireacha agus ó dheirfiúracha, ó bhaill eile teaghlaigh, nó go fiú ar an teilifís (TG4). Labhair cibé Gaeilge atá agat le do pháiste, agus tá sé chomh tábhachtach céanna go labhraíonn tú Béarla a mhinice is féidir. Is scoil dhátheangach Gaelscoil Uí Néill agus cuireann sí béim ar an Ghaeilge agus ar an Bhéarla agus, cé nach bhfaigheann na daltaí teagasc foirmiúil i mBéarla go dtí Rang 3, agus spreagaimid páistí chun Gaeilge a labhairt a mhéad is féidir sa bhaile.

Uniform

Gaelscoil Uí Néill's uniform is as follows:

- red jumper with school crest;
- white T-shirt with collar;
- black/ grey trousers or skirt; and
- back shoes

The uniform is available from No. 5, The Lineside, Coalisland.

Please write your child's name on all items of clothing, including his/her coat.

Physical Education

As part of the Revised Curriculum, the pupils will receive instruction in Fundamental Movement Skills. The P.E. kit consists of a T-shirt, shorts and plimsolls. Pull on plimsolls are the easiest for the children to manage and plimsolls with laces are not permitted. Please ensure that your child's name is written on his/her P.E. kit.

Language

As an Irish-medium school, all teaching staff will speak solely in Irish to your child. It is also important that your child also hears Irish outside school, from parents, siblings or other family members, or even on the TV (TG4). Use whatever Irish you have with your child, but it is equally important that you also speak to your child in English as much as possible. Gaelscoil Uí Néill is a bilingual school and stresses the development of both Irish and English and, while the pupils will not receive formal instruction in English until Primary 3, we therefore encourage children to speak as much English as possible at home.

Tinneas

Béilí

Ceannaítear béilí scoile ó scoil máguaird. Is féidir le hairgead dinnéir a thabhairt ar bhonn laethúil nó ar bhonn seachtainiúil. Is é £2.20 an praghas (Is féidir go n-athróidh sé seo). Má shíleann tú go bhfuil tú i dteideal Béilí Saora Scoile is féidir foirm a fháil ó oifig na scoile. Is féidir le páistí lón pacáilte a thabhairt isteach chun na scoile, ba chóir a leithéid a choinneáil scartha ó leabhair scoile ar eagla go mbeadh sileadh ann.

Smacht Scoile

Tá sé de rún ag rialacha ranga, scoile agus clóis bealach chun sábháilteacht agus ord a chinntiú agus timpeallacht a chinntiú inar féidir le foghlaim tarlú. Illness

If your child has any illness, health problems or allergies please inform the teacher. While not encouraging absenteeism, please do not send your child to school if he/she is sick. Meals

School meals are brought in from a local school. Dinner money can be paid on a daily or a weekly basis. The price is £2.20 (subject to change). If you think you are eligible for Free School Meals you can obtain a form from the school office. Children may also take a packed lunch to school, this should be kept separate from school books in case of spillage.

In Gaelscoil Uí Néill, all pupils are expected to behave in a responsible manner both to themselves and others, showing consideration, courtesy and respect for others at all times.

- Léigh le do phaiste a mhinice is féidir, i mBéarla nó i nGaeilge.
- Bain lánúsáid as an leabharlann áitiúil.
- Déan aithris ar rannta páistí agus spreag do pháiste chun iad a fhoghlaim de ghlanmheabhair.
- Déan aithris ar an aibítir le do phaiste.
- Amharc ar an teilifís le do pháiste agus pléigh na rudaí a tharlaíonn ar na cláir a bhfuil dúil ag do pháiste ann ina dhiaidh.
- Spreag do pháiste chun scríobh agus tarraingt a mhéad is féidir. Glacann sé tamall fada do pháiste bheith compordach le peann luaidhe. Spreag do pháiste chun a n-ainm a scríobh a mhinice is féidir. Úsáid ceannlitir i gcónaí ag tús ainmneacha, ba chóir an chuid eile bheith sa chás beag.
- Déan iarracht lena chinntiú go dtéann do pháiste a chodladh go luath. Bíonn deacrachtaí ag páistí codlatacha foghlaim agus ní bhaineann siad sult as an scoil.

Ways to Help Your Child

- Read to your child as often as possible, either in English or in Irish.
- Make full use of the local library.
- Recite nursery rhymes to your child and encourage him/her to learn them by heart.
- Recite the alphabet to him/her.
- Watch TV with your child and discuss what happens on the shows he/she likes afterwards.
- Encourage him/her to write and draw as much as possible. It takes a long time for a child to become comfortable with a pencil. Encourage your child to write his/her name as often as possible. Please only use a capital letter at beginning of name, the rest should be lower case.
- Try to ensure that your child goes to bed early. Sleepy children find it difficult to learn and don't enjoy school.
- Play is very important for the education of young children. Play develops imagination as well as movement and manipulation skills.
- Talk to your child about everything. Look for simple words and numbers in the environment and discuss these with your child.
- Let your child help around the house, with the washing up, tidying up or with simple and safe cookery acts.
- Bring your child shopping with you and let him/her help with putting the shopping away. Sorting is the most important mathematical skill in the first two years of education.
- Encourage your child to dress/undress independently as he/she will need to do this in PE
- Ensure that your child can put on/take off his/her coat.
